Archivist's Processing Notes

These data were converted from IBM packed decimal to EBCDIC by the Archives. Several logical records were compared to the record layout, coding scheme, and actual reported figures from selected schools. The information in the file seemed to be consistent with the documentation. Ethnic data was not reported for the Educational Support Program in Kenosha, the Lakeside Children Center in Milwaukee, and Taylor High School.

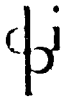

- 5. OTHER.** Persons not included in columns 1 through 4 including CAUCASIAN.

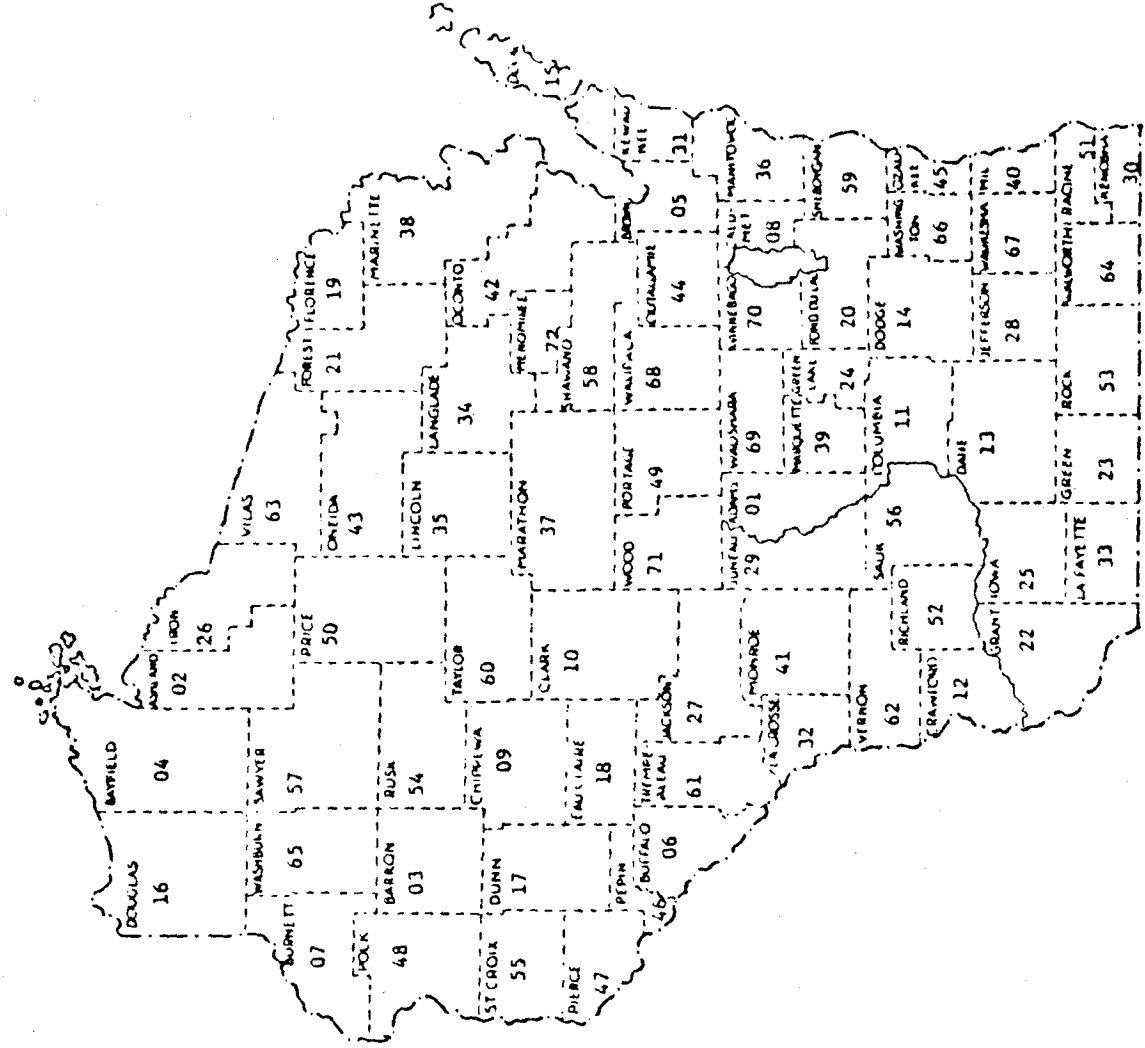

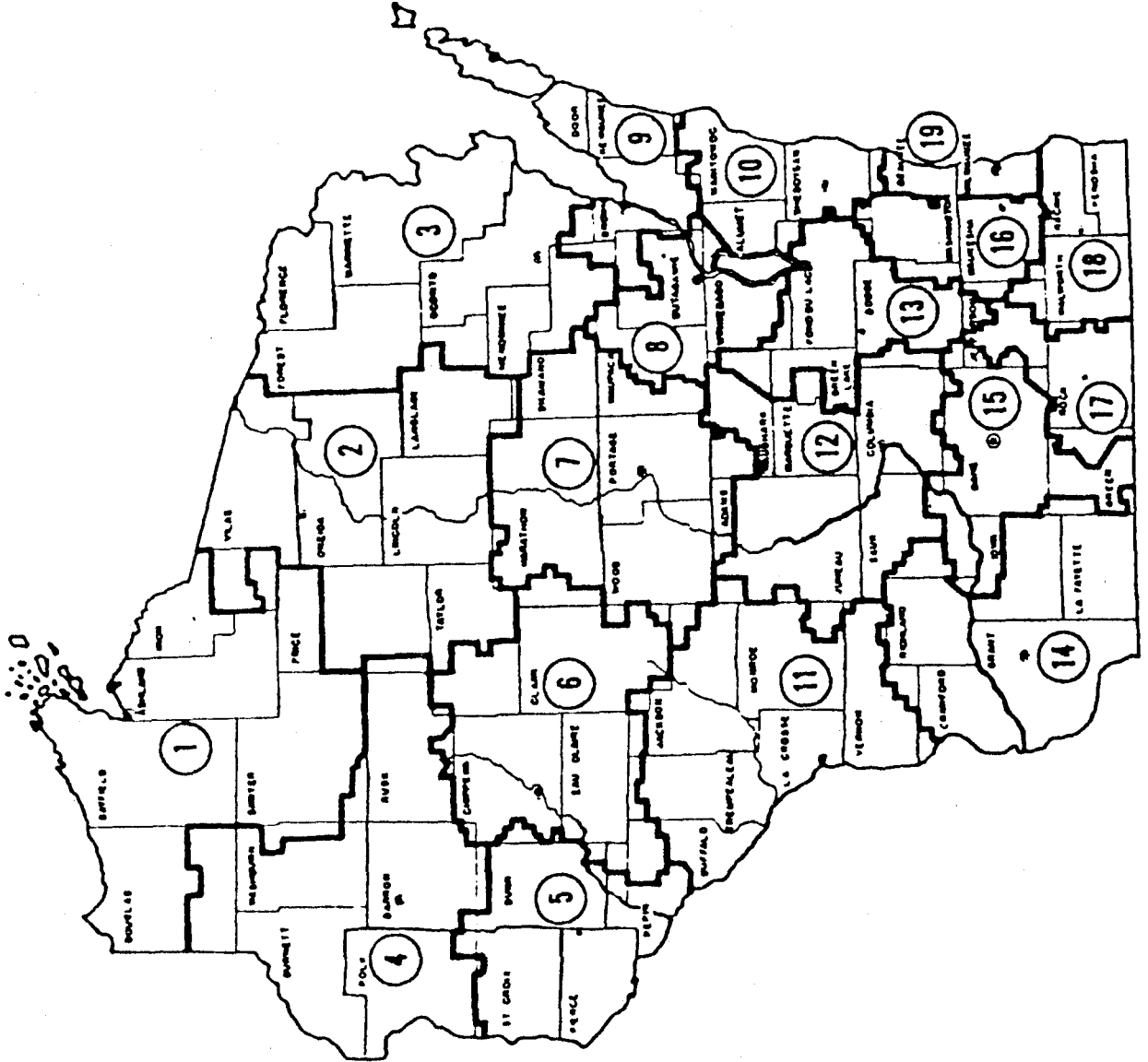
